



First Aid Course

MVARA has the opportunity for members to take part in a basic **First Aid Course** run by **Meon Valley Heart Start**, which is a registered not for profit charity running courses at multiple venues around our area of Hampshire.

The course, which would be **one session** of approximately **2 hours 30 minutes**, would involve a considerable amount of practical interaction, including resuscitation mannequins and defibrillators. It would be led by **volunteers** and would be **free of charge**, although participants would be able to make donations to the charity. All monies received are used to support the free delivery of the courses to the local Community.

If we have **20 participants**, we can have our own course and Heartstart would run it at a **convenient local venue**. (Previous courses have been held at the Men's Shed and the King's Church in Bishop's Waltham). If we have fewer members interested, there could be the opportunity to join a pre-planned open group with spaces in the locality.

The course would not turn anybody into a qualified all-singing, all-dancing first aider, but would give participants a good idea of what to do (and what not to do) in an emergency.

We would be aiming for a course in **March/April**.
